## Why should children be vaccinated against COVID-19?

Vaccinating **children** against COVID is important

Parents should consider:



We (your healthcare providers) **recommend** that your child get vaccinated



COVID vaccination in children prevents new infections, and more importantly — it prevents **serious disease and hospitalization. Rate of hospitalization in children due to COVID-19 is 2 – 4 times higher in the unvaccinated.**

# 90% effective

COVID vaccination in children works — it's 90% effective in preventing **serious disease, hospitalization and death.**



COVID vaccination in children is **safe** — far safer than serious disease from a COVID infection



COVID vaccination in children **protects kids just like car seats and bike helmets.**



COVID vaccination reduces the risk of kids passing COVID to vulnerable adults, like grandparents, and those with weak immune systems.



COVID vaccination in children increases the overall vaccination rate which will reduce the number of COVID variants
