



Penicillin Allergy Decision and Mobile Empowerment (PADME)

Parents of children with unverified penicillin allergy labels are encouraged to use **Penicillin Allergy Decision and Mobile Empowerment (PADME)**, to initiate the penicillin allergy de-labeling process.

Parents can complete a simple online assessment at <http://www.padmeallergy.org/> to receive their child's personalized risk certificate to share with their child's doctors.

Parents will also receive risk-based guidance about the next steps necessary for removing or testing a penicillin allergy label. Steps may include de-labeling with their primary care doctor or testing through allergy specialists, such as Cincinnati Children's [Penicillin Allergy Testing Services \(PATS\)](#) clinic.
